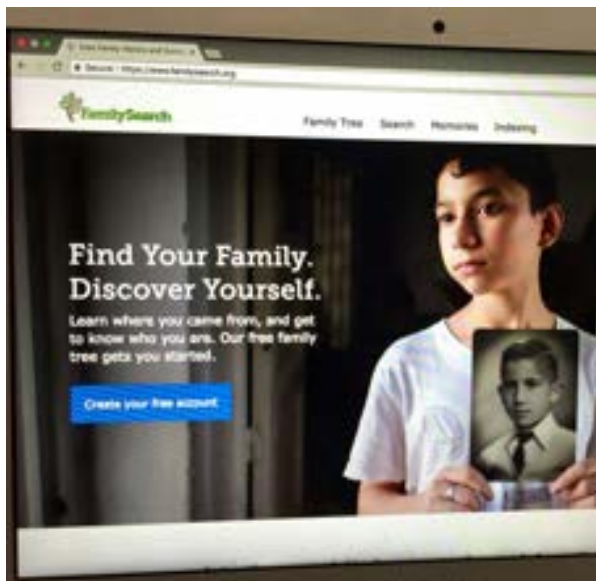

There is no cost to visit a Family History Center. Operated by The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints members and volunteers.

The Family History Center is in the back of the building on the left side of the parking lot. Walk through the patio for door entrance. The Family History Center has free access to FamilySearch, Ancestry, Find my Past, MyHeritage and other genealogy websites. Staff is available to help you with your research. **Parking Lot Gate is open on Alta Loma Drive.** Parking is free.
